Institute for Technology in Healthcare Clinical Engineering Scholarship

Five senior students are eligible for the award this year. The recommendation for the award will be made by the Graduate Awards Committee of the Institute of Biomaterials and Biomedical Engineering of the University of Toronto. This historic award will be given to the outstanding student in the Clinical Engineering program at the Institute based on academic performance during tenure in the Program. This prestigious and historic award will bring honour to both the student who receives it and the Institute at the University of Toronto

Clinical Engineering Thesis award

The Institute for Technology in Health Clinical Engineering thesis award will first be awarded in 2008 and the five students who are completing their thesis' will be eligible. The award will be for the thesis project that most closely demonstrates the importance of an innovative engineering solution and the addressing of a real clinical patient care problem effectively.

In both cases the Institute for Technology in Healthcare will be notified of the recipients for these awards. These two awards has ensured that the Institute for Technology in Healthcare has a direct impact on the clinical engineering students in our program and has enhanced the profile of the Program at the University of Toronto.
